Women's Lacrosse Participates in Friends of Jaclyn Week



The Marist women's lacrosse team, in conjunction with the Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Coaches Association (WLCA), recently participated in Friends of Jaclyn Week as they hosted the Columbia Lions in a non-conference game on March 7th, 2009. The goal of the Friends of Jaclyn (FOJ) foundation is to improve the quality of life for children suffering from pediatric brain tumors, by matching the child with a high school or college team based on geographic location. The Red Foxes hosted one of 10 games to raise awareness for the foundation. Jaclyn Murphy, 11, who was the inspiration of the foundation, is a resident of Dutchess County.

Jaclyn was diagnosed with medulloblastoma, a form of malignant brain tumor, in March 2004. She is currently in the sixth grade and has been adopted by the Northwestern women's lacrosse team. Murphy will attend a Marist women's lacrosse game on April 7 against Colgate at 4p.m. at Tenney Stadium at Leonidoff Field. The Marist women's lacrosse team is currently on a waiting list to adopt a friend through the foundation.
