- <u>Bullying Workshop (DASA)</u> (Saturday, November 2nd from 9:30 am-12:30 pm in HC 2023). <u>YOU MUST register</u> with Mrs. Brennan by Friday, October 4th by emailing Mrs. Brennan (<u>lisa.brennan@marist.edu</u>) regarding your intent to complete the online portion, along with your CWID, home address, cell phone number, preferred email, last FIVE (5) digits of SS#, and your DOB. Watch for an informational email with details to be sent out early in the semester.
- <u>Child Abuse Seminar</u> DO ONLINE at <u>www.nysmandatedreporter.org</u> and bring proof of completion to Mrs. Brennan in DY 388 ASAP!!

*Also, because so many area schools require fingerprinting for student teaching, we ask that **all** candidates be fingerprinted by the state of New York <u>before the end of their junior year</u>. Go to a MorphoTrust location to have your FINGERPRINTS taken and submitted for background check (see <u>https://uenroll.identogo.com/workflows/14ZGQT</u> for locations and further information). ***NOTE** that for New York Certification, you must complete ALL the required certification exams (EAS, CST(s)) before receiving your teaching certificate, and ideally BEFORE student teaching. The edTPA will be completed DURING student teaching.
