Description: This chart shows the education and employment placement outcomes of Marist 2015 graduating class (undergraduates only) by school.

Sources: Following the methodology from last year, the data was compiled from the following sources: Next Step Survey (Sept.-Oct. 2015), LinkedIn/Social Media (Nov.-Dec. 2015), National Clearinghouse (Nov. 2015), Alumni Survey (February 2016) and the gathering of data from across campus: Deans, athletics, internship coordinators, & others.

Employment data was self reported in response to our surveys, or reported on Social Media. Education status was self report, found on LinkedIn/Social Media, or verified in the National Clearinghouse.

Definition: Knowledge rate is the percent of graduates for which the institution has reasonable and verifiable information concerning the students' post-graduation career activities.

Other Notes: Data in the chart as of March 3, 2016. The 2014 data utilizes a similar collection process, while the data for 2013 consisted of only a single survey in March of 2014.
