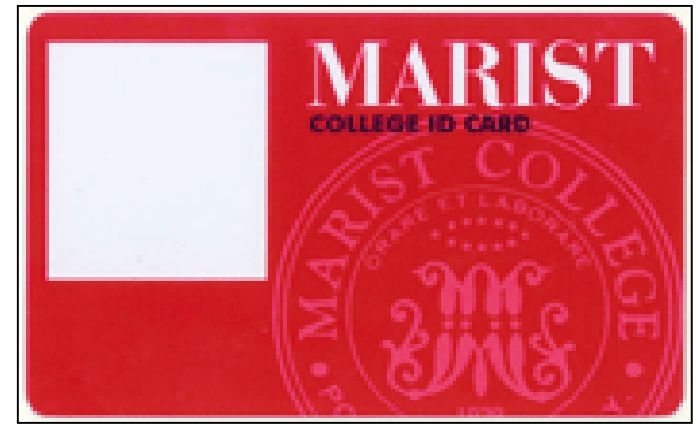

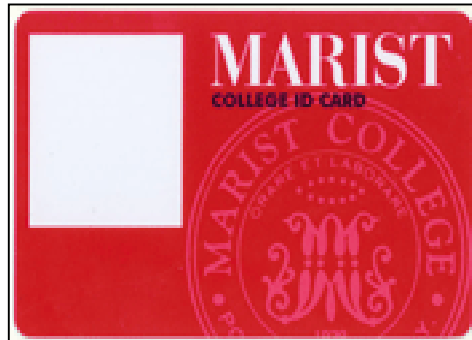
Your I.D. is your ticket to Cashless Campus Commerce

What is Marist Money?

- Marist Money is a money management account you can set up for your student.
- By setting up a Marist Money account, the student can use Marist Money to purchase items on campus, as well as off campus.
- Every student will receive a Marist ID. On the ID is their meal plan, thrifty cash, dorm access, and Marist Money. Everything is on one card.

- **No cash withdrawals**

MARIST MONEY

- Marist money carries over from semester to semester, year to year.
- If you leave the college or graduate you will receive a refund if you have \$20 or more in your account.



How Do I Deposit Money?

- Deposits can be taken over the phone with a MC, VS or DS card.
- Students can deposit money onto their account at our office directly.
- Checks can be mailed to our office.
- You will always need to know the student's CWID #.

ON-LINE DEPOSITS



- **You can now make on-line deposits with your credit card: mastercard, visa or discover.**
- **Go to Marist Money website and select “**make a deposit**”**
- **You need to know the student’s cwid # and their birthdate**
- **Minimum of \$25 deposit**

PAYROLL DEDUCTION

- If the student has an on -campus job, they can have money deducted from their paycheck.
- Fill out a payroll deduction form to have your I.D. card loaded with Marist Money via payroll deduction.
