1. Submit a copy of test results, including WAIS subtest scores (abbreviated WAIS *not* acceptable) and current levels of achievement in reading, mathematics and written language as determined by *individual achievement* test scores. Scores must be recent within 3 years.
2. A copy of your most recent IEP/504 plan must also be submitted if you had one in high school.
3. Include an unofficial copy of your high school transcript and SAT/ACT scores.
4. Include 2 letters of recommendation from teachers, tutors (someone who is familiar with your learning style).
5. Attach your essay.
6. Enclose the \$25 application fee.
