The Quadricentennial Regatta is a re-enactment of the Poughkeepsie Regatta which was held on the Hudson River from 1895-1949. During the 54-year span, the area in front of Marist's Historic Cornell Boathouse was

home to the Inter-collegiate Rowing Association's (IRA) National Championship race. In conjunction with the 400th anniversary of Henry Hudson's voyage up the river, Marist College will host the Quadricentennial Regatta on Saturday, Oct. 3, 2009 at 9 a.m. A number of original and current stewards will return to the Hudson River for the event, including Columbia, Cornell, Navy, Pennsylvania and Syracuse.
