

MARIST COLLEGE EVENT POLICY GUIDELINES

Marist College's COVID-19 policies, procedures and guidelines are informed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), New York State, Dutchess County, and our in-house medical advisory group. The following policy should be used by the College's operating areas to plan College events during the Spring 2022 term. **This policy does not apply to day-to-day campus facility operations such as classrooms, dining hall, library, athletic center, among others.** Information regarding the College's COVID-19 operating policies and procedures can be found at <https://www.marist.edu/covid-resources>.

The College reserves the right to modify its procedures and take additional measures to manage public health as appropriate. These measures may include, but are not limited to reducing capacity, limiting services such as catering, or the cancellation of events.

Marist Alert Level: Orange

Outdoor events

- Masks required at all times.
- **Food may be served in single-wrap servings or with crowd management strategies.** Masks are not required while persons are stationary and eating/drinking.

Indoor events restricted to members of the Marist community

- Venues may operate at **50% capacity and social distancing may be required.**
- **Masks must be worn indoors regardless of external guidelines.**
- **No food or drink may be served**
- Attestation not required for Marist community members (student, staff, faculty).
- External lecturers or performers must attest to completed COVID-19 vaccination series/negative PCR test within 72 hours of event. **Physical on-site verification of vaccination may be required for external lecturer or performer.**

Indoor events that include non-Marist participants

- Venues may operate at **50% capacity and social distancing may be required.**
- **Masks must be worn indoors regardless of external guidelines.**
- Children 2-12 must be masked when not eating or drinking
- **No food or drink may be served**
- External guests must attest to completed COVID-19 vaccination series/negative PCR test within 72 hours to attend event. **Physical on-site verification of vaccination may be required.**
- **No external visitors to Marist residence halls allowed.**

Indoor events sponsored by Marist off campus

- Venues may operate at **50% capacity and social distancing may be required.**
- **Masks must be worn indoors regardless of external guidelines.**
- Children 2-12 must be masked when not eating or drinking.
- **No food or drink may be served**
- External guests must attest to completed COVID-19 vaccination series/negative PCR test within 72 hours to attend event. **Physical on-site verification of vaccination may be required.**
- In addition to Marist COVID policies and procedures, guests must follow relevant COVID policies of event venue.
