Dear New Student,

We are looking forward to your arrival on campus for Transfer Opening Day on **Friday, August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2021**. Below is the move-in schedule for new incoming transfer resident students. Please refer to this schedule to determine your arrival time and designated parking area. It is extremely important that you adhere to the move-in schedule, as students arriving early cannot be accommodated ahead of their scheduled time.

Transfer Orientation will occur on Saturday, August 28<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, August 29<sup>th</sup>. Here is the [schedule for orientation](#) from the Office of First Year Programs and Leadership Development.

Student volunteers will be at the entrances of campus to direct you to your appropriate parking lot. To make the move-in process convenient for you, staff and students will be available to assist in unloading your belongings and moving them to your room for you. **Elevators will not be available for public use on Opening Day.**

To ensure that none of your belongings are misplaced, we ask that, prior to your arrival, you prominently display your **name, residence hall, and room number** on ALL boxes, bags, and/or suitcases. The College will make every effort to ensure that your belongings arrive in your room. **However, the College will not accept liability for any lost or damaged personal belongings.** Use your discretion when giving any items of high or personal value to our staff and students.

Please keep in mind that over 100 families are moving into the residence halls that day. Therefore, we would encourage you to bring only those items that are most necessary for the first few weeks of school. Family Weekend 2021 is currently scheduled for September 24 – September 26, and this is a good time to have additional items brought to you by your family. Please see the [attached list](#) of items we suggest you purchase locally after you arrive on campus. We also encourage you to review the list of [items not permitted in the residence halls](#).

**As a reminder, students must be COVID cleared (proof of vaccination or an approved exemption) in order to participate in the early drop-off opportunity. There will be no exceptions. In accordance with recent College policy, all students and guests will also be required to wear a mask while indoors during the drop-off opportunity and on Opening Day.**
