MADRID, Oct. 3.—(By the Associated Press.)—The health of King Alfonso, who is ill with influenza, continues poor today. Members of the royal family will leave San Sebastian today for Madrid, but the king will remain behind for a few days.

LONDON, Monday Night.—Renter's correspondent at Madrid says that King Alfonso, the Premier, and other Ministers, and 30 per cent of the population of Spain, are suffering from an unknown epidemic, the symptoms of which are high fever, pains in the chest, and diarrhoea. The disease is of a mild nature.



First Wave


Started in Fort Riley, Kansas






