





Effects of Lifelong Learning on Cognitive Decline





Effects of Lifelong Learning on Cognitive Decline

- 1.Vemuri, P. et al., JAMA Neurol. 2014, Aug: and 71(8):1017-24mid/late life cognitive activity, were significantly associated with longitudinal change in cognitive performance (p<.001)
- 2. Lesnick, T.G. et. al, Neurology 2016 Mar 22;86(12):1128-35 intellectual enrichment (high education, high midlife cognitive activity) is associated with lower amyloid in APOE4 carriers
- 3. Murray, A.D., et. al. Brain, 2011 Dec;134(Pt 12):3687-96.
 educational enhancement has a measurable and positive effect, with a standardized regression weight of +0.23, on late life cognitive ability


