

Application for Marist Science Research Program

Supported by the School of Science

The School of Science at Marist College has competitive funding available to support several science majors who are committed to pursuing research projects under the supervision of a Marist faculty member. The purpose of the funding is to provide real research experiences for students who have a genuine desire and ability to pursue scientific research. Interested students should initially make contact with a faculty member who is willing to donate his or her time to advise a student. The student should then discuss a suitable project to pursue over this time.

The program can commence during the spring 2017 semester and continue up until the end of June 2017. Funding will cover a student stipend and limited expenses for supplies. Preference will be given to students with a strong academic record and a commitment to scientific research.
