Join artist Madeleine Segall-Marx for a tour of her art installation, “The Singing Bowl: Voices of the Enemy,” on Thursday, October 1, 2026, from 2 to 4 pm at her home and studio at **WaveCrest**, Hyde Park. The exhibit includes 25 works in different media based on stories from countries in armed conflicts. Madeleine has presented her project to the UN Commission on the Status of Women. She has studios in New York City as well as Hyde Park.

The visit begins at Madeleine’s home where she will explain the origin and construction of the works, then proceed to the nearby barn where the art is displayed.
