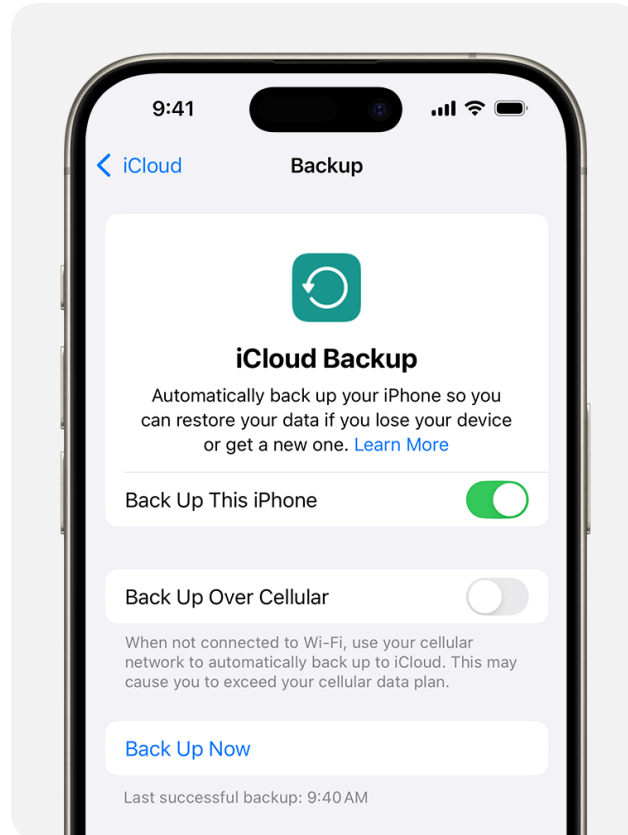

Updating Apple devices

For Apple products, ensure your devices are running the latest versions.

Before updating to a new IOS version, it is a good idea to do a full backup of your phone. There are several options to do this such as using Apple's iCloud **backup feature**.



Backing up your iPhone using iCloud Backup

Step 1: Select iCloud Settings

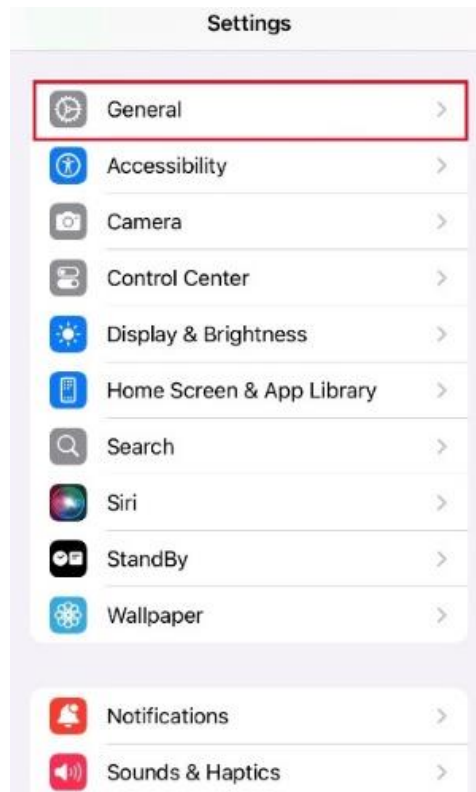
- In Settings select > your name (sign into iCloud if not already signed in) > iCloud.

Step 2: Select iCloud Backup to Back up your phone

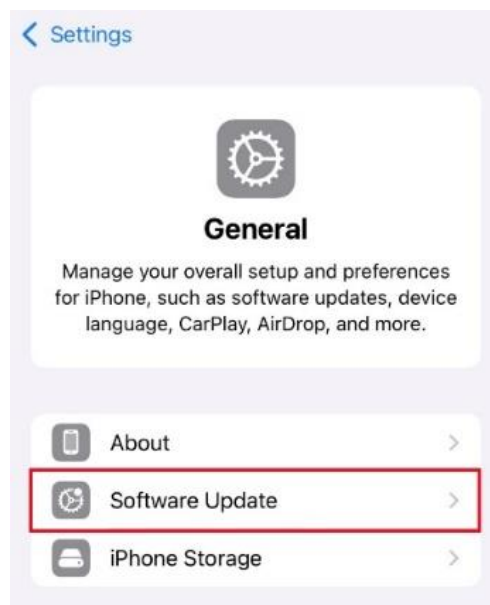
- Select iCloud Backup > Back Up This iPhone.
- This will start to Back up your iPhone. Backups take periodically snapshots of your phone. You can also select Back up Now to take a backup at the present moment.

Step 1: Select the **Settings** app 

Step 2: Scroll down and select the **General** section.



Step 3: Select the **Software Update** section.



Step 4: If there is an update available, tap on **Download & Install**. You will be prompted for your passcode. Your Apple device will then download and install the update.

How to update apps on Apple devices

Step 1: Locate the App store

- Go to the App store on your Apple device.
- Tap on the profile icon on the top right.

Step 2: Update your apps

- Scroll down then tap Update next to the apps you want to update. You can also tap Update all.
