Updating Roku Devices

Before updating your Roku devices, it is recommended to do a backup of your Roku device. While Roku does not have a built-in manual backup feature, you can effectively preserve your settings and preferences by linking your Roku device to your Roku account. This ensures that your installed channels, purchased content, and viewing history are automatically saved and can be restored on a new Roku device by signing in with the same account.

Backing up Roku Devices

Step 1: Verify Account Linkage

- Press the Home button on your Roku Device.
- Navigate to Settings > System > About.
- Ensure your Roku device is linked to the correct Roku account.

Step 2: Enable Channel Synchronization

- Roku automatically sync installed channels across devices linked to the same account.
- Any purchased or subscribed channels will be restored when you log in to a new device.

Step 3: Save Preferences and Payment Information

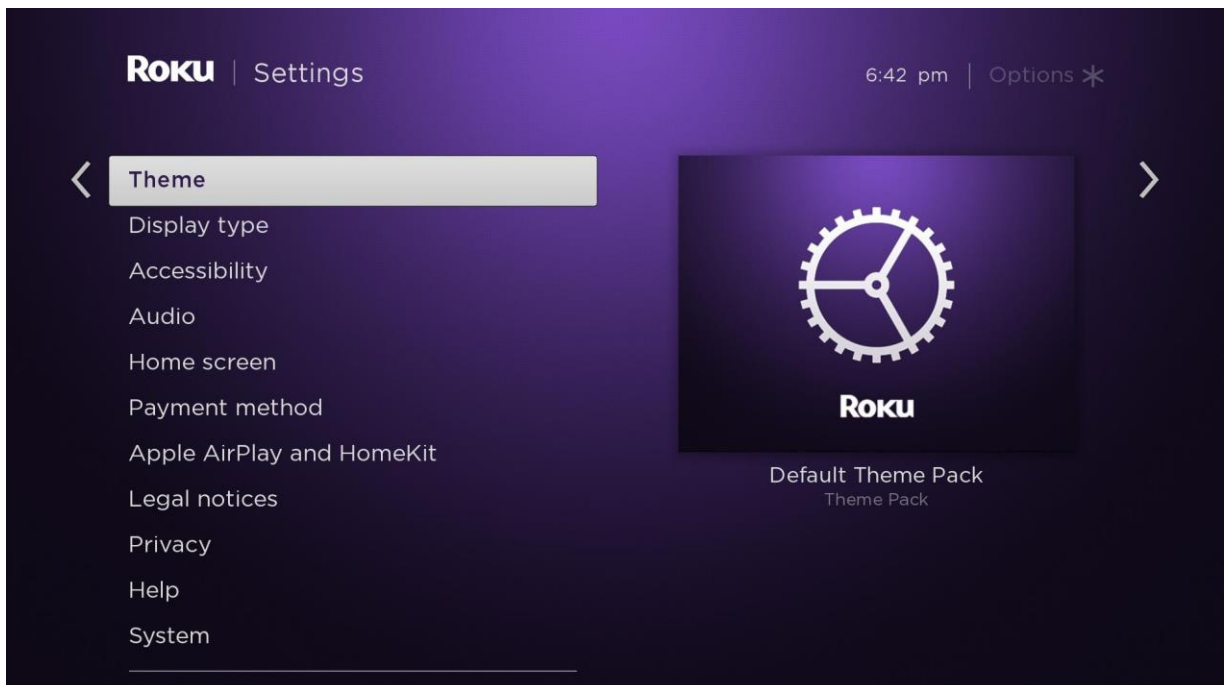
- Visit my.roku.com and sign in.
- Ensure your payment method and subscriptions are updated.

Roku Update Instructions:

By default, your Roku device is designed to always run the latest version when connected to the internet. You can, however, always manually check for an update through the Roku settings.

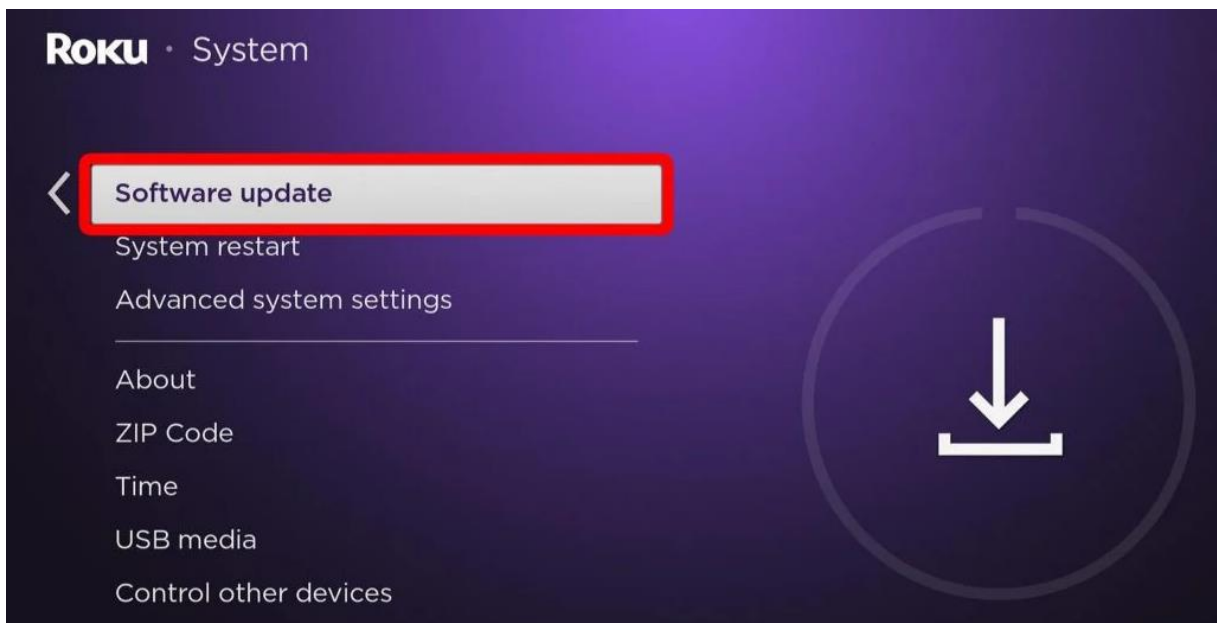
Step 1: Go to Roku Settings

- Press the Home button on your Roku Device and select Settings.



Step 2: Go to Software update Settings

- Select Software update.



Step 3: Check for Update

- Select check now to manually check for an update and follow the on-screen instructions.
