## Updating Nintendo Switch Consoles

Before updating your Nintendo Switch Consoles, it is recommended to do a backup of your Nintendo Switch's saved data. This can be done via Nintendo's Save Data Cloud Backup feature. This will allow you to back up your Nintendo Switch's saved date to the cloud. Keep in mind you will need an active Nintendo Switch Online membership to use this feature.



## Backing up your Consoles saved data to the Cloud

#### Step 1: Go to Save Data Cloud Settings

• Select System Settings > Data Management > Save Data Cloud > Select your User.

#### Step 2: Select which games you want to upload

- Scroll down to settings > Automatic Save-Data Backup.
- Turn this option on, this will automatically save your game data to the Cloud.
- Additionally, scroll down to Advanced Save-Data Settings.
- Here you can individually select which games are Backed up.

### Nintendo Switch Update Instructions:

#### Step 1: Turn on Your Nintendo Switch Console.


Press the **Power** button on your Nintendo Switch to turn it on.

#### Step 2: Go to System Settings.

From the **Home menu**, navigate to the **System Settings** icon (gear-shaped icon). Scroll down and select **System**.

### Step 3: Check for System Updates

Under the System menu, select **System Update**. The Switch will check for any available updates.





### Step 4: Update Console

If an update is available, it will show an option to download and install it. Select **Update** and follow the on-screen instructions.

### Step 5: Wait for the Update to Complete

The Switch will download and install the update. The system may restart during the process. Do not turn off the console while it's updating.
