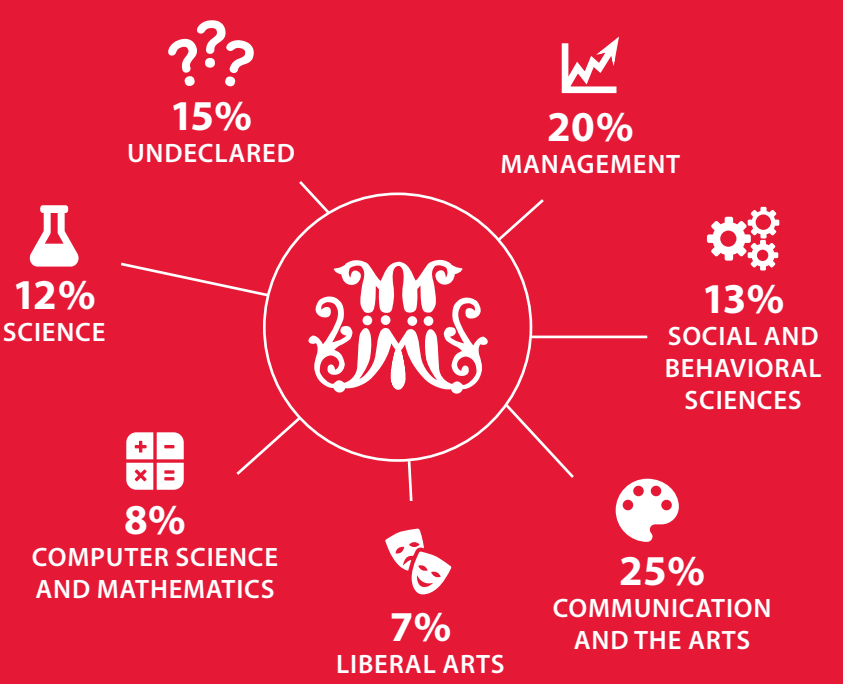

# Class of 2026 Profile

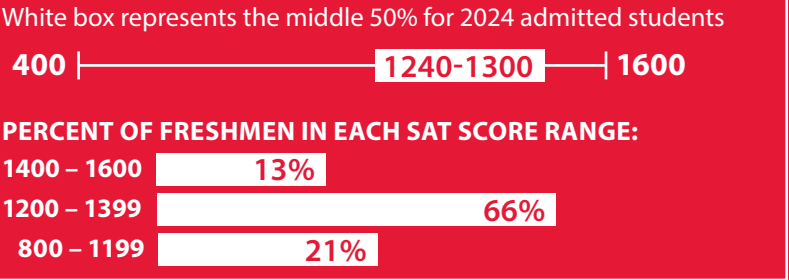
## Enrolled Freshmen by Choice of Major/Study



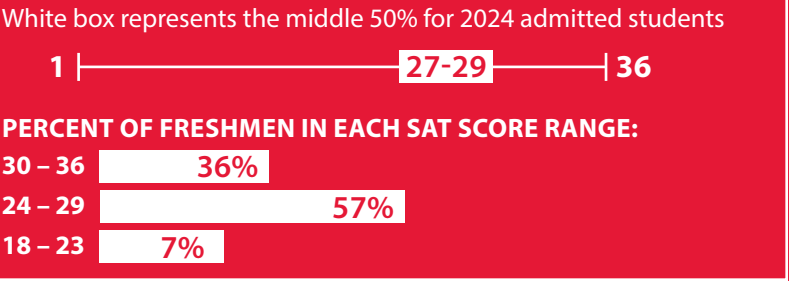
### Test-Optional Policy:

Marist has a test-optional policy for admission. Applicants are NOT required to submit SAT or ACT scores to receive consideration for admission or merit scholarship. Thirty-nine percent of the 2024 applicants chose not to submit test scores. In the past five years, the acceptance rate for submitters and non-submitters has been very similar.

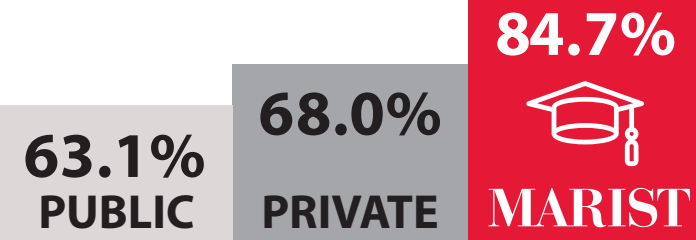
