Waiver Justification Area:

If two concentrations, should be 21 and 24 credits. If more than two concentrations, must have a minimum of 12 credits in each concentration. All but 12 UL credits can be transferred from another school. Students must have a minimum of 21 upper level (300 and 400) credits. Please put a * next to the upper division classes.

Minimum of 120 credits must be earned for a bachelor's degree. If a BA, there must be a minimum of 90 credits in liberal arts. For a BS, there must be a minimum of 60 credits in liberal arts.

Please note that in order to qualify for graduation honors (cum laude, magna cum laude, etc) you must complete a minimum of 60 credits at Marist. Students who transfer in more than 60 credits from other institutions will not qualify for these honors.
