- Students will be living in air conditioned 4-person suites in the North End Housing Complex on Marist's Campus.
- Each suite is made up of single occupancy rooms connected to a common room and include a refrigerator, microwave, and bathroom.
- Each floor has lounges for studying and hanging out and there is a laundry facility available for student use in the building.

The Summer Pre-College programs are staffed by a professional resident director, an assistant resident director, and paraprofessional student resident assistants. The staff will be living in the residence hall and will be there to assist with any issues, ensure your health and safety, and provide fun programs during your down time. Students will have meals in Marist's recently renovated dining hall.

Participating in this unique experience, however, requires some responsibilities. As members of the learning community, summer students are expected to meet the challenges of the rigorous academic program and participate with enthusiasm in all community activities. It is also expected that personal integrity and respect for the rights of others combined with a positive attitude will enable students to maintain the highest standards.
