

Deposit Required after Securing Your Marist VISA

Securing a Marist VISA does not guarantee you placement in the upcoming semester. You must make your deposit, provide official transcripts, and register for classes before all the seats in the upcoming semester are taken.

Notify Marist when you receive your VISA.

If your appointment was not successful tell us if you will interview again provide the new interview date to Marist.

A \$1,500 non-refundable deposit is required within 10 business days of receiving your VISA. Your deposit is not an additional fee. The entire amount is applied to your first semester tuition.

Official Transcripts

If you have not already sent official transcripts to Marist, send them now. Find instructions in your acceptance letter attachments. (Official transcripts must be sent by your prior college or university in a sealed envelope delivered to Marist by courier)

Send your official transcripts so they are received within 10 business days of securing your Marist VISA.

Your Marist I-20 can be cancelled, and you can lose your deposit

If a deposit is not made by the required date and your official transcripts are not received, your I-20 will be cancelled, you will not be able to travel with your Marist VISA, you will lose your deposit, and your place will be offered to another student.
