

# Registration

#### You must register to reserve your place in classes.

- Send official, hard copy transcripts and complete your deposit before you can to register.
- Registration starts in April for Fall/August admission. Registration starts in November for Spring/January admission.
- You will receive an email when it is time to register for classes. Reply to that email to register.
- If classes fill, we will have a waiting list for students who want to register and attend.
- Students on the waiting list are not guaranteed attendance. They may need to defer to the next Fall or Spring semester.

### **First Semester Classes**

MSIS students will have three of the four following classes assigned during the first semester.

- Systems & Information Concepts in Organizations
- Data Management I
- Data Communications
  - If Data Communications is full, you may be placed in Systems Analysis and Design

MSCS students will have the three following classes assigned during the first semester. First semester classes vary. They frequently are:

- Object-Oriented Programming in Java
  - Students who pass the placement exam with a "B" or better will be given an alternate class in their Concentration
- Database Management Systems
- Course in your Concentration
  - o Artificial Intelligence students take Machine Learning
  - Cloud Computing students take Networking

The first semester classes will be assigned by your Program Director.

## **On Campus Classes**

Two or more classes must be on campus to meet with your F-1 VISA requirements.

One class per semester may be taken online if you are in the MS in Information Systems degree.

All classes are on campus for the MS in Computer Science degree.
