## **Seniors & Opioid Overprescribing**

**NEARLY** 

agree that opioids are being overprescribed

are concerned that taking opioids can lead to addiction and dependence are specifically concerned that their peers are taking too many opioids

**Despite** these concerns, risky behavior is occurring:

#### **LEFTOVER PILLS**

About one-third of respondents who have been prescribed opioids keep unused pills in their home



#### **MISUSE**


Nearly 40% use leftover opioids to treat pain associated with conditions the drugs were not prescribed to treat
