Trip 1: D & H Canal & Museum Tour **1315 NY 213, High Falls, NY 12440**

Fri. May 5, 2023
Cost: \$10

Time: 10:00am tour starts (*arrive by 9:45am*)
Limit: 30 maximum

The Delaware and Hudson Canal Museum specializes in the history of The Delaware River and the Canal. The Hudson Canal was built to transport coal from the mines in northeast Pennsylvania to markets on the Hudson River. We will have a guided tour of the museum and the 5 Lock walk which accesses the locks 16-20 of the former canal. You can visit their website at: <https://www.canalmuseum.org>

Trip 2: DIA Beacon **3 Beekman Street, Beacon, NY 12508**

Mon. May 8, 2023
Cost: \$22

Time: 1:00pm (*arrive by 12:45pm*)
Limit: 20 maximum

The tours are about 1 hour and visitors are encouraged to walk around on their own following the tour. The galleries encompass about 240,000 sq. ft. so you'll want to have time to explore, if you can. A two hour visit is perfect. The café will be open from 9:45am until 4:00pm.

Tour the house known as Rock Hill that Aaron Copland bought in 1960 and lived in until his death in 1990. The House is a designated National Historic Landmark. Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination (including booster shot) - due by March 17, 2023
