### Trip 1 - Scenic Hudson Headquarters

**Description:** Tour Scenic Hudson's new headquarters on the north side of Poughkeepsie which is situated on a net-zero sustainable campus. Formerly an abandoned factory, the building incorporates solar power and green spaces and will be utilized for public events and education. Tour the building and learn about the renovation of this historic building and why it was chosen. The site is accessible and handicapped parking is available.
